

## DISCUSSION CASE



### Case description:

*62-year-old Female presents with the lesion shown. She noted the lesion three to four months ago. She remains mostly asymptomatic, although did give a history of occasional irritation of the site associated with the consumption of spicy / acidic foods. Her medical history is significant for hypercholesterolaemia and depression. She is a non-smoker and does not drink alcohol.*
